

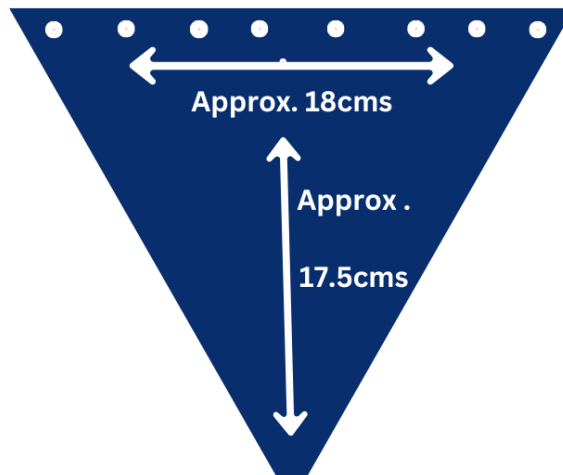
# Pennant Knitting Pattern

## Materials

- 20g Red, White or Navy DK yarn
- Size 4mm needles

## Finished size

- Approx. Width 18cms
- Approx. length 17.5cms



## Abbreviations

- yfwd: Yarn forward
- k2tog: Knit two together
- s1k1pss0: Slip one stitch, knit one, pass slip stitch over



*The pennant is knitted in garter stitch, with eyelets at the top edge*

## To Begin

Cast on 40 stitches

1st Row: K

2nd Row (*creating the eyelets*): K2, (yfwd, k2tog, k3) repeat 7 times, yfwd, K2tog, K1

3<sup>rd</sup> Row : K

## Subsequent Rows

Rows 1-3: Knit.

Row 4: K1, s1k1pss0, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, K1.

*(You are decreasing 2 sts on every 4th row)*

Repeat these four rows until 4 stitches remain.

## Finishing

Knit 1 row

Cast off.

Please sew in any loose threads

Enjoy your knitting!

*Knitting tensions vary. If you find your pennant is not quite the same size as the pattern specifies changing needle size should help. Please still submit any pennants you have made as we will match them with others of a similar size.*
